



Kraemer Dance Team Rules and Policies

- A minimum grade point average of 2.0 and a citizenship grade of Satisfactory or higher must be maintained at all times. Violation will result in probation and/or suspension and/or dismissal from the team.
- All school rules and policies must be followed at all times while on campus or at any school or dance team event.
 - Dress code violation: warning, phone call to parents
 - Drugs and/or alcohol: immediate dismissal from the team
 - Other inappropriate behavior is punishable at the discretion of the coach
 - Suspension from school for any reason includes suspension from the team including all scheduled events and possible dismissal from the team
- Dancers are required to wear team clothing and stay with the team at all dance team events unless special arrangements have been made with the coach prior to the event.
- All scheduled practices and events are MANDATORY, *not optional*. Dancers are required to arrive at call time and stay the duration of the event. Leaving the event and returning will not be permitted.
- Absences and tardies exceeding five minutes require a parent’s note or it will count as an absence.
 - If a dancer is absent two or more days the week of a competition or the day before a competition the dancer may be prohibited from competing.
 - Five absences over the course of the year will result in automatic probation.
- Dance clothes are to be worn at all practices with appropriate shoes, hair and jewelry.
- Parent attendance at monthly meetings is required
- Parent participation is required: signing-up to carpool and attending team events
- Parents are expected to pay the monthly tuition on time or to set-up a payment schedule with the coach and team treasurer.

Each team member has the responsibility of maintaining the prestigious reputation of the Kraemer Dance Team. This means being eager to attend practice, performances, competitions, and always dancing to the best of their ability. Sportsmanship is also emphasized, therefore, each team member should always be prepared to support and encourage each other as well as other teams.
